Cabo Verde, September 2-13

AFW2 work program execution at mid-year is on course, picking up momentum from the beginning of FY 2020. Thirty-five (35) TA missions, four (4) regional workshops and a professional attachment were completed in the period August – October 2019.

Summary of Work Plan Execution and Key Achievements

Tax Administration

In the second quarter, work in tax administration focused on strengthening intelligence and investigation capacity in Cabo Verde to improve compliance towards strengthening revenue administration management. Work continued from Q1 in Ghana to strengthen the GRA's Strategic Planning capacity, as it took steps to operationalize its 3rd Strategic Plan. Progress was made towards improving core tax administration functions with TA provided in excise duties management and telecom sector audit capacity (Liberia).

Customs

CD provided in the period aimed at improving customs administration functions and strengthening governance arrangement. A significant part of the work centered on the development of customs integrity strategies in line with the ECOWAS model framework. AFW2 countries have, as a result, developed logical frameworks, integrity policy, and action plans for implementation.

Additional work supported the development of risk management strategies and standard operating procedures (SOPs) for review of risk profiles for risk management committees in Ghana and Sierra Leone. An HQ-led assessment of the Ghana Revenue Authority was conducted in Q2. Gambia, with assistance from AFW2, made progress on drafting a new strategic plan. The Gambian Revenue Authority also received intermediate training on customs valuation and classification, developing capacity for future training.

The post clearance audit (PCA) unit in the Nigerian Revenue Authority received training in PCA and was supported to draft and submit SOPs.

Public Financial Management (PFM)

In PFM, support was given to fragile states in mitigating fiscal risks from state-owned enterprises. the Department of Public Private Partnership (DPPP) in the Gambia developed of an IFRS-based training curriculum for its staff and formulated a roadmap for adopting SOE performance-based contracts. In Sierra Leone, officials received training on fiscal risks related to PPPs, leading to a request for more targeted training on the PPP Fiscal Risk Assessment Model (PFRAM). Additionally, TA support strengthened capacity in strategic medium-term budgeting (Ghana, Nigeria).

Monetary Operations (MONOPS)

A highlight of CD in monetary operations and payment systems was the strengthening of the analytical toolkit of research departments to improve forward-looking monetary policy analysis and forecasting (Ghana, Liberia, Nigeria). Fragile states are now able to forecast the consumer price index (CPI) and composite indicators of economic activity (CIEA) 6 months ahead. The CIEA is now being presented to the Monetary Policy Technical Committee (MPTC) in Nigeria. In Ghana, forecasting for policy analysis (FPAS) is supporting the central bank's inflation targeting regime.

Finally, a regional workshop and in addition to a mission in Sierra Leone strengthened monetary policy communication capacity. Sierra Leone has



now issued its first ever Monetary Policy Report in September 2019.

Banking Supervision and Payment Systems

TA in banking supervision continued to target Basel II/III implementation (Ghana, Liberia, Nigeria) and strengthened risk-based supervision (RBS) (Gambia, Sierra Leone). A regional workshop on the Basel Core Principles (BCP) Self-Assessment Methodology helped the central banks to identify and address gaps in their supervisory processes. The Bank of Sierra Leone and Central Bank of Gambia completed a draft RBS manual and draft RBS framework, to be used for training supervisory staff.

Statistics

AFW2 supported the rebasing of GDP (Cabo Verde, Gambia). The Gambia Bureau of Statistics (GBoS) is working toward finalization of rebased GDP by expenditure approach. Cabo Verde continues to work on rebasing annual national accounts with base year 2015. The main data sources for rebasing have been prepared and the first analyses to ensure the data sources consistency will start soon. Further progress was made by the Nigeria Bureau of Statistics (NBS) toward the development of the Supply and Use Tables SUT spreadsheet for compiling rebased GDP, and on sourcing data and refining the bridge tables.

AFW2 Center Outreach and Other Activities

The center continued to make efforts to raise awareness about the fund's CD mandate and strengthening coordination among donor partners and regional bodies. A number of presentations were organized; (i) to the Civic Society Organizations in Ghana to share highlights and observations from Phase I (2014 – 2019) and strategies going into phase II; (ii) to development partners on the integration of CD and surveillance. Major themes of discussion were the implications of the new Ghana Beyond Aid vision for CD in Ghana and strategies for enhanced coordination among CD providers.

In October, the center also hosted students of Economics from the University of Copenhagen, while the Center Director participated in the IMF RCDC Retreat and met with country authorities in Cabo Verde.



Regional Workshops

Regional Workshop on Monetary Policy Communication, September 2-6, Accra, Ghana

This workshop was organized to expose high-level central bank staff, top management, and MPC members to the concepts of communication, and equip them with the tools and techniques to improve that communication.

This workshop focused on delivering Basel Core Principles Self-Assessment Methodology to member countries and Guinea. critical in getting the jurisdictions to conduct honest self-assessments of gaps in their supervisory processes and take appropriate measures to address them.

Joint Regional Workshop on Revenue Administration Governance with FAD HQ, AFRITAC East, AFRITAC South and AFRITAC West 2, September 23 – 25, Cape Town, South Africa

This seminar was designed to create a platform for discussion and interaction and update participants in the fields of good governance and autonomy and revenue administration.

Regional Workshop on System of National Accounts 2008 (with WAIFEM), October 28 – Nov 8, Accra, Ghana

AFRITAC West 2 hosted a twoweek training course on Systems of National Accounts 2008, in collaboration with the West African Institute for Financial & Economic Management (WAIFEM), with staff from central banks and statistical agencies in attendance.
