AFRITAC West 2 (AFW2) Center Director, Mr. Oral Williams, and Economist, Ms. Pokuaa Adu, embarked on an outreach visit to Abuja, Nigeria. Meetings with country authorities at the Ministry of Finance and Central Bank of Nigeria (pictured) were aimed at strengthening awareness of AFW2 capacity development activities in Nigeria, understanding of the government's specific CD needs and channels for continuous coordination between the center and the authorities. The Center Director, Mr. Oral Williams was present at the opening of regional workshop on Strengthening Fiscal and Financial Reporting, as part of an outreach visit to the Gambia.

Summary of Work Plan Execution and Key Achievements

Tax Administration

Work in tax administration supported the strengthening of audit capacity for the telecom sector in Liberia and Nigeria. An HQ mission followed on revenue administration reform in Nigeria, based on recommendations of the previously conducted TADAT. Sierra Leone also benefited from TA to build excise duties management capacity and improve data analysis

using third party data matching to support risk-based compliance management.

Customs

In Customs, CD continued to focus on developing customs integrity framework in line with ECOWAS guidelines (Cabo Verde and The Gambia), risk management and exemptions (Cabo Verde) and stakeholder engagement strategies (Gambia, Sierra Leone). In Cabo Verde,

a risk management committee was established to implement RM strategy and the related M& E framework. The resident customs advisor also participated at a regional IMF workshop in Benin, including a presentation on post clearance audit controls.

Public Financial Management (PFM)



CD was undertaken towards improving transparency through improved financial reporting in Cabo Verde, focusing on measures needed to comply with cash based international accounting standards and to assist in the development of a roadmap for transitioning to accrual based International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS).

Risk management and budget forecasting capabilities were improved in Ghana, Nigeria and Sierra, through the delivery of TA in PPP risk management, budget performance monitoring and cash flow forecasting. Sierra Leone received CD in the use of excel-based forecasting models and review of the Sierra Leone Integrated Macroeconomic Model (SLIMM).

Banking Sector Supervision & Regulation

Capacity development in the financial sector regulation and supervision continued to focus on enhancing the effectiveness of regulatory and supervisory practices for AFW2-member central banks. Work intensified in the areas of strengthening risk-based supervision processes in the Gambia and Ghana. An emergency training was delivered to senior supervisory staff of the Central Bank of Liberia on dealing with weak banks.

Statistics

CD work in statistics continued to support member countries in developing national accounts.

In Ghana, progress was made with the balancing of Supply and Use Tables (base year 2013). This enabled to the production of preliminary figures for the rebased annual and quarterly GDP, timeseries of years 2013-2018, and for backcasting series to 2006. The final estimates are expected to be released in April 2020.

In Liberia, the second phase of national accounts rebasing has been completed and data from the National Accounts Annual Survey has been processed and administrative sources for data not covered by the NAAS have been provided. Progress has been made on the compilation of preliminary results.

Finally, Statistics Sierra Leone (Stats SL) has completed the fieldwork of the Annual Economic Survey of Enterprises (AESE) 2019. Further progress was achieved in the data processing and analyses of the 2019 AESE and 2018 Sierra Leone Integrated Household Survey (SLIHS) results. Both surveys are very important for rebasing of GDP by the production and expenditures approach.

Regional Workshops

Regional Workshop on Strengthening Fiscal and Financial Reporting, December 2-6, Banjul



AFRITAC West 2 hosted a regional workshop on Strengthening Fiscal and Financial Reporting in the Gambia. Senior officials from ministries of finance in all member countries made country presentations on international best practices and country experiences in fiscal reporting. Participants were exposed to the latest developments in applicable reporting standards (both GFSM and IPSAS) and best practices for financial and fiscal reporting. The workshop was highly interactive and facilitated knowledge sharing through presentations on country experiences with fiscal reporting in PFM and other related issues.

Regional Workshop on Cross Border Supervision, November 17 – 22, Abuja



Staff of central banks in AFW2 countries and Guinea were hosted at the Central Bank of Nigeria's International Training Institute (ITI) for a regional workshop on Cross-Border Supervision in Abuja. The workshop activities included instruction by the AFW2 regional advisor and short-term experts from the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, as well as breakout groups to facilitate peer-to-peer learning. Participants at the recently-held Cross Border Supervision Workshop worked in groups on case studies to share experiences and exchange ideas for effective banking supervision.
